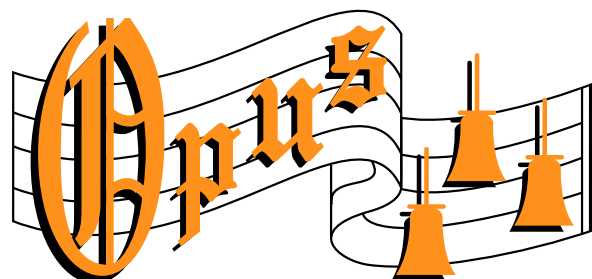
We trust you will be awed by the musicianship and inspired by the art of handbell ringing.
